Purpose:

Scholarship availability may also be announced through schools of nursing and via other WIACNS communications. The WIACNS Scholarship Committee's recommendation shall be approved by the WIACNS Steering Committee. Successful scholarship recipient(s) will be notified via email.

Application criteria

- Applications must contain evidence of WIACNS organization involvement to be eligible for submission. Examples include meeting attendance, committee work, and chapter presentations. Committee work includes effort/work at or outside of meetings; committee chairs will validate. Application must include the name of a WIACNS sponsor.
- Activities must occur in the period for which award application is made, that is, 1 Jan – 31 Dec of the calendar year. In some cases, the reporting period may also include the prior year. Applicant should indicate the years of service for which credit is claimed
- Applicants must submit proof of activity with application (except for WIACNS chapter meeting attendance, which is tracked from attendance logs). Documentation suggestions appear below.
- Applications will be evaluated by the WIACNS Scholarship Committee. Applications should be submitted to the committee chairperson by the date specified, usually in early January. The Scholarship Committee reports its recommendations to the Steering Committee for review and approval.

Application Documentation - Include with application at time of submission

- Presentations: copy of program or agenda listing the presentation
- National committee: copy of listing on website or newsletter/publication; copy of correspondence relating to participation
- Certification: copy of current certification
- Precepting/mentoring: description of your activity/role documented by your supervisor
- Nursing research: description of project and your activity/role documented by your supervisor
- Publications: 1st page of article/chapter with title, name (& journal name); table of contents & title of book/journal
- Professional contact: copy of correspondence or record of interaction
- Media contribution: copy of written item or reference to program
- Community event: PR statement from institution; flyer, program, or attendance record
