



## **MOVIN Student Hourly Research Assistant**

### **Job Description**

Come work with the MOVIN Team in the School of Nursing! MOVIN stands for Mobilizing Older adults Via a systems-based Intervention (<https://movin.nursing.wisc.edu/>). This is a large, multi-site, multi-year study about an in-hospital intervention that supports nurses ambulating patients. MOVIN is hiring student hourly research assistants to support participant recruitment, data collection, data entry and development of large, complex quantitative data sets. Responsibilities may include in-hospital patient recruitment and data collection, data collection through EHR, data entry, preparation of data collection packets, and other research office support as needed. We may split the positions so that some team members are primarily office-based working on data and others are primarily recruitment-based on the hospital units.

### **Knowledge, Skills and Experience:**

#### Office-based roles:

- Familiarity with EHRs or demonstrated ability to learn new technology quickly.
- Intermediate Microsoft Excel skills.
- Weekday availability.
- This role would be best suited for someone who is very organized, excels at managing details and has highly developed time management skills.

#### Recruitment-based roles:

- Health care experience or health sciences student required.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills for recruiting older adult hospital patients into the study.
- Ability to follow research study protocols accurately.
- Consenting or research data collection experience preferred.
- Weekday and/or weekend day availability.

These positions are not eligible for remote work.

Diverse voices and experiences play a valuable role in the rigor, significance, innovation and translational potential of our scientific work. We strongly encourage applications from individuals belonging to communities that have been historically excluded from research, including those related to socioeconomic status, race/ethnicity, gender identity, sexual orientation, neurodiversity, and disability. We also welcome applications from non-US citizens.

### **Time Commitment and Pay**

Pay range \$15-25 per hour depending on experience. 6-20 hours per week. Shifts available during weekdays and weekends, primarily daytime hours. We are looking for candidates to begin as early as June and up through the start of Fall 2022 semester.

Recruitment-based role: This job requires you to interact with older adults in a hospital setting. Briefly describe your experience working in a healthcare setting or communicating research to a lay audience.
