EMT EXPERIENCE PROGRAM

THE EMT EXPERIENCE PROGRAM IS A TWO-YEAR LONG PROGRAM THAT SEEKS TO INCREASE ACCESS, EQUITY, AND DIVERSITY IN HEALTHCARE.

THE FULL PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- Full scholarship for EMT certification through Madison College in summer 2024 for up to two students
- Two years of structured volunteer service, professional development sessions, mentorship from the Mt. Horeb Fire Department and additional healthcare providers
- Dedicated career development support from the Center for Pre-Health Advising

Two additional students may participate in the structured volunteering and mentorship component. These additional students will have to pay for certification on their own but are eligible to receive reimbursement for their certification costs after completing 368 hours of volunteer shifts at FDMH.
