

Directions to UW-Madison School of Nursing

Bus:

Bus stops are located at the intersection of Observatory Drive & Highland Ave. Bus routes that service the area include: 2, 9, 11, 28, 38, 44, 80.

Free Campus Shuttle Bus (Rte 80): take the bus to UW Hospital & Clinics, on the far western end of campus. Disembark at the corner of Observatory & Highland; in front of Signe Skott Cooper Hall. Enter Cooper Hall; the Office of Academic Programs & Student Services is on the first floor, Suite 1100.

Biking on Campus:

Find your way to Observatory Drive and ride it to its west end point where it meets with Highland Ave, Cooper Hall will be on your right. Bike racks are located on the Observatory Drive side of the building. Enter Cooper Hall; the Office of Academic Programs & Student Services is on the first floor, Suite 1100.

Moped Parking:

There is moped parking next to Cooper Hall, directly in front of Lot 85 on Observatory Drive. (A permit is still required.) Enter Cooper Hall and the Office of Academic Programs & Student Services is one the first floor, Suite 1100.

Driving Directions:

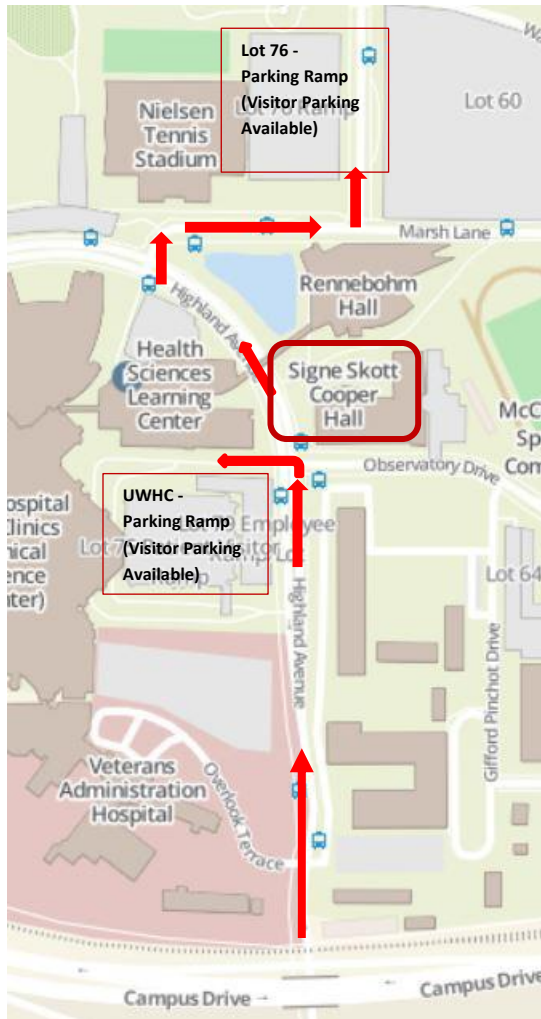
Downtown/Main Campus Area, drive west on University Ave, University becomes Campus Drive. There is one exit on Campus Drive (before it reverts back to University Avenue), Highland Ave. Take the Highland Ave exit and turn right onto Highland. The School of Nursing is on the right, corner of Highland Ave and Observatory Dr (2nd stop light). The Office of Academic Programs & Student Services is in the main atrium, Suite 1100.

From East Hwy 12/18, take US Hwy 12-18 east (Beltline) to Verona Rd/Midvale Blvd exit and turn left onto Midvale (*proceed below to **Midvale Avenue** directions*).

From I-90 into Madison, take the US Hwy 12-18 exit/west. You'll be driving west on the Hwy 12/18 (South Beltline) for 11 miles. Take the Verona Rd/Midvale Blvd exit, exit 258, and turn right onto Midvale (*proceed below to **Midvale Avenue** directions*).

From West I-94 from Milwaukee, coming into Madison, take the I-39 S/I-90 E exit towards Janesville (Exit 4A). Move into far right lane and drive for 4.2 miles. Exit on US Hwy 12/18 west (Beltline) towards Madison (Exit 142A). You'll be driving west on the Hwy 12/18 (South Beltline) for 11 miles. Take the Verona Rd/Midvale Blvd exit, exit 258, and turn right onto Midvale (*proceed below to **Midvale Avenue** directions*).

Midvale Avenue -Drive all the way to the end of Midvale Avenue (approximately 2.5 miles) where it will intersect with University Ave. Turn right onto University Ave and drive east for approximately 1 mile. Stay in right lane, do not take Campus Drive. Turn left at traffic light at University and Highland Ave. The School of Nursing is on the right, corner of Highland Ave and Observatory Dr (3rd stop light). The Office of Academic Programs & Student Services is in the main atrium, Suite 1100.



Visitor Parking:

UW Hospitals & Clinics Visitors Parking Ramp: Turn left at the intersection of Highland Ave and Observatory Dr (across from the School of Nursing) and follow the sign for the ramp. After walking out of the ramp, turn right and take the sidewalk back to the intersection of Highland Ave and Observatory Dr, cross the street into Cooper Hall. The Office of Academic Programs & Student Services is on the first floor, Suite 1100

University Bay Drive Lot 76 Parking Ramp: Stay on Highland Ave, continue past the School of Nursing to the stop sign for Marsh Lane. Turn right. Turn left at the next stop sign, University Bay Dr, and enter the parking ramp. Exit the ramp on foot, cross Marsh Lane and take the sidewalk that goes between Rennebohm Hall and the pond. Cooper Hall is the next building. Enter Cooper Hall and the Office of Academic Programs & Student Services is one the first floor, Suite 1100.

There is no visitor parking in lot 85, which is behind Cooper Hall.
