**Description:** 11 NCLEX Review Sessions, most in-person, some online. During the session students will practice in-group and on their own to answer questions on the content laid out in the tentative schedule below.

In the sessions, students will practice using effective strategies to answer different types of questions commonly seen in the NCLEX: Multiple-choice, Multiple-Response, Fill-in-the-blank (calculation), Hot-Spot, Chart/Exhibit, Drag and Drop into Ordered Response, Graphic Options, and Audio Items.

**Aim:** The purpose is to help graduating nursing students prepare for the NCLEX.
