What is Student SEED?

Student SEED is a 3-credit, high-impact seminar that engages students in interactive dialogue about the impacts of race, socio-economic status, gender, sexual orientation, dis/ability status and our additional social identities on our personal lives, on our communities, and on society. We will share from our own lived experiences and engage in critical reflection on the complex social issues we face.

Each class session, we will explore critical questions about racial & social justice, self-awareness, accountability, and action through interactive activities, dialogues, reflective practices, and group exercises/projects.
