This graduation update is regarding two things happening next Tuesday, April 25, 2023.

- 1. Graduation Walkthrough Tuesday, April 25, 12:00-12:45pm, Cooper Hall Room 1321
 - Next Tuesday we will hold a graduation walkthrough for BSN students attending the Nursing Baccalaureate Graduation
 Celebration. During the walkthrough, we will go over the general schedule for the day, reporting times and locations, student seating, and will overview what happens during the event as well as the route and expectations during the 'stage walk.'
 - After the walkthrough, we will send out documents detailing the above information to all students both as a reminder and for those who are unable to attend the walkthrough on April 25.
- 2. Guest Ticket Pickup Tuesday, April 25, 12:45-1:30pm, Cooper Hall Room 1321 (TBSN)/Curran Commons (ABSN)
 - Immediately following the graduation walkthrough:
 - TBSN students can stay in 1321 for graduation guest ticket distribution.
 - ABSN students should head to Curran Commons (by the fireplace) for graduation guest ticket distribution.
 - When you pick up and sign for your guest tickets, you officially take full responsibility for them. Tickets cannot be replaced
 if lost, stolen, or forgotten/left at home.
 - Guest tickets that are not picked up by 1:30pm on April 25 will be held at the Academic Affairs Front Desk and can be picked up during business hours (typically M-F, 8am-4:30pm) from April 26-May 11, 2023.
 - Guest tickets are general admission. Guests can sit anywhere as long as the row does not have a reserved sign on the arm of
 the aisle seat (for student seating), or the seat itself does not have a School of Nursing reserved sign on it (for staff seating and
 ADA accommodations). If you requested an ADA accommodation, we will be reaching out to you individually regarding your
 request.
