2. Gates open at 3:30 p.m. Please note the ceremony typically lasts approximately two and a half hours. A livestream of the ceremony will be available [here on YouTube](#).
3. Guests, family members and friends are welcome to attend. There is no ticketing for guests nor is there a limit to the number of guests. **Seating is general admission, first come, first served.** Guests and graduates in need of accommodations should see our section below about Kohl Center Accessibility. 4. The graduate entrance is located at Gate A (West Dayton Street entrance). Access to candidate seating is via the grand staircase located outside Section 127.
5. No guests, including children (with the exception of graduates who are nursing parents) are permitted in the candidate seating area. No food or beverages of any kind are permitted. Please review the [carry-in policy](#) to plan accordingly.
